

LITTLE ROCK YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEER

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents/guardians who have children participating within the Little Rock Youth Football & Cheer League must abide by a Code of Conduct, which includes the provisions that follow. Any violation of these rules may result in the revocation of privileges in the Little Rock Youth Football & Cheer League.

1. I/We agree to furnish proof of Birth -i.e.: Original Birth Certificate, Passport or Military ID of applicant to the Association/Conference at the beginning of the season upon request.
2. I/We agree to furnish the most recent school year's original Report Card to the Association /Conference at the beginning of the season and again when requested mid season. (Mascots & Mitey Mites are exempt.)
3. I/We agree to furnish a current original utility bill or other acceptable proof of residence address to the Association/Conference at the beginning of the season upon request.
4. I/We agree that my child will participate in the "Scholar Athlete Awards program" set up by the Golden League Youth Football Conference. (Except Mascots and Mitey Mites.)
5. I/We agree to be financially responsible for Association equipment/uniform issued to applicant other than the normal wear and breakage during games and practice, further I/We will reimburse the Association/Conference for the loss and/or damage to said equipment.
6. I/We agree to not smoke on the practice or playing field, or in the presence of a gathering of the team/squad. (ex: after game/practice team/squad meetings.)
7. I/We agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Association/Conference function.
8. I/We agree not to deliberately incite or participate in "unsportsmanlike" conduct at ANY Association/Conference function.
9. I/We agree not to use abusive or profane language at any time at any Association/Conference function.
10. I/We agree not to criticize, belittle, antagonize, berate or otherwise incite the opposing team, its players, coaches, cheerleaders, fans, officials/judges, Board Members or Commissioners by word of mouth or by gesture.
11. I/We agree to accept all decisions of the game officials, judges or Conference Officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
12. I/We agree to follow the proper Chain of Command when filing a complaint or voicing my opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern within my Association or the GLYF organization.

The Chain Of Command will be as follows:

You may only advance to the next level in the chain of command providing your situation has not been handled within 72 hours from your initial filing and you need further assistance.

A. The Head Football Coach or Head Cheer Coach of your Association.

* If your complaint is regarding a Coach you may go directly to your Football/Cheer Director or the Association President.

B. The Football or Cheer Director of your Association.

C. The President of your Association. For almost every issue, the President of your Association will be the highest authority you will consult with.

- In rare cases, a letter may be written to the Golden League Youth Football Conference only if a GLYF rule has been broken and you have been granted permission by an Association President. GLYF will not overturn a decision made by an Association unless it is in violation of GLYF/AYF rules or it is within its right according to GLYF rules.

- If you go directly to Golden League Youth Football without permission from an Association President, you will be removed from this Conference WITHOUT the right to appeal (with the exception of rule 15.b.)

- Also, if you go directly to American Youth Football you will be removed from this Conference WITHOUT the right to appeal. Only Commissioners have permission to contact American Youth Football and they are the liaison for the Conference.

13. I/We agree not to interfere with or come near the “Scale Area” at the football field, where the weigh-in and pre-game check-in is taking place.

14. I/We agree to refrain from destroying school property, or involving ourselves with any illegal acts while on school property.

15. I/We agree to take responsibility for any actions that violate this Code of Conduct by a guest or relative of attending parent/guardian.

16. a. Any act of disrespect from a parent/fan directed towards game officials/judges, or Conference officials, creating a disturbance either in the stands or on the playing field, or has to be ejected from the game, practice or event, by the Conference official or game official, the penalty will be handed down to that individual immediately by the Conference official, and the assessed penalty will not require a hearing to be assessed.

b. However, any penalty assessed by GLYF to any individual may be appealed in writing to the Conference Board of Presidents, within 72 hours from the time the penalty was assessed. The appeal will be handled in accordance with the Golden League Youth Football Administration Bylaws.

By signing this “Code of Conduct” we are in agreement with the terms and conditions listed above and understand that any deviation from this may lead to removal from the Littlerock Youth Football and Cheer Organization.
